

## Erosion Control/Shore Stabilization Project

MUD 500 is officially moving forward with its ShoreSOX™ erosion control project at various locations around MUD 500's lakes. The purpose of the ShoreSOX™ project is to rehabilitate existing erosion and help to protect the lakes against future erosion, which helps to mitigate against expensive lake bottom dredging while maintaining the look and feel of the lakes.

MUD 500 has contracted with Double Oak Erosion to install the ShoreSOX™ along the north side of the Heritage Sections 3 and 4, Heritage Cove Section 60, the north and south side of Tuckerton Bridge, the shoreline north of BASU, and the shoreline north of the Towne Lake Parkway bridge near the Welcome Center.



The project is scheduled to begin on October 21<sup>st</sup> with an estimated completion date of December 20<sup>th</sup>. Stay tuned for more information on temporary closures of trails and other facilities around the lake edge as we undertake this important project.
